

MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW (EXCERPT)
Act 116 of 1954

168.426/ Candidates for judge of municipal court; certificate of determination by board of canvassers.

Sec. 426*l*. The board of county canvassers shall determine which candidates for judge of the municipal court of record received the highest number of votes and on that basis shall declare the candidates duly elected, specifying the terms to which each was elected. The board of county canvassers shall immediately make and subscribe on its statement of returns a certificate of the determination and deliver it to the city clerk.
