

**SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 4112**

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled  
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"  
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 905a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           **Sec. 905a. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person**  
2 **licensed under this act to sell alcoholic liquor for consumption on**  
3 **or off the licensed premises at retail shall post in a conspicuous**  
4 **location a sign informing the public of the effects of alcohol**  
5 **consumption during pregnancy. The sign must contain the message:**  
6 **"Pregnancy and alcohol do not mix. Drinking alcoholic beverages**  
7 **during pregnancy can cause birth defects." The commission shall**  
8 **include the message required under this subsection in the sign**  
9 **furnished by the commission under section 701.**



1           (2) If the person described in subsection (1) sells alcoholic  
2 liquor for consumption on the licensed premises, instead of posting  
3 a sign the person may place the message required by subsection (1)  
4 on a menu.

5           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days  
6 after the date it is enacted into law.
