SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4303

A bill to provide for the official time followed in this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) If the United States Congress amends 15 USC 260a 2 to authorize states to observe daylight saving time year-round, it
- 3 is the intent of the legislature that daylight saving time shall be
- 4 the year-round standard time of this state and all of its political
- ${f 5}$ subdivisions in that part of this state that is in the Eastern
- 6 Standard Time zone and in that part of this state that is in the
- 7 Central Standard Time zone.
- **8** (2) It is the intent of the legislature that the time change
- ${f 9}$ described in subsection (1) take effect only if all of the

- 2 (a) Wisconsin.
- 3 (b) Illinois.
- 4 (c) Indiana.
- 5 (d) Ohio.
- 6 (e) Pennsylvania.
- 7 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 8 date it is enacted into law.
