HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 74

A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled

"Enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 28.304), as amended by 2018 PA 47.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 4. (1) The secretary of state may issue an enhanced 1 2 driver's license or enhanced official state personal identification 3 card to an applicant who provides satisfactory proof of his or her full legal name, United States citizenship, identity, date of 4 5 birth, social security Social Security number, residence address, and a photographic identity document. If the applicant is a program 6 7 participant in the address confidentiality program under the 8 address confidentiality program act, he or she shall present to the





secretary of state his or her participation card issued under the
 address confidentiality program act. An applicant may choose to
 apply for a standard driver license or standard official state
 personal identification card or an enhanced driver license or
 enhanced state personal identification card.

6 (2) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
7 personal identification card shall must include reasonable security
8 measures to protect against unauthorized disclosure of personal
9 information regarding residents of this state that is contained in
10 the enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal
11 identification card.

(3) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state 12 13 personal identification card may include radio frequency 14 identification technology that is limited to a randomly assigned 15 number, which shall must be encrypted if agreed to by the 16 Department of Homeland Security, and does not include biometric 17 data. The secretary of state shall ensure that the radio frequency 18 identification technology is secure from unauthorized data access 19 and includes reasonable security measures to protect against 20 unauthorized disclosure of personal information. An applicant must 21 sign a declaration acknowledging his or her understanding of the 22 radio frequency identification technology before he or she is issued an enhanced driver license or enhanced official state 23 24 personal identification card.

(4) The requirements of this act are in addition to the
requirements otherwise imposed on individuals who apply for a
standard driver license or standard official state personal
identification card.

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(5) The holder of an enhanced driver license issued under this



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act is subject to every licensing sanction provided under the 1 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923. As used 2 in this subsection, "licensing sanction" means the restriction, 3 suspension, revocation, or denial of a driver license; the addition 4 of points to a driving record; until October 1, 2018, the 5 6 assessment of a driver responsibility fee; the assessment of a 7 civil fine or criminal penalty resulting from a conviction; a civil 8 infraction determination; the imposition of probationary terms and 9 conditions; or any other penalty provided under the Michigan 10 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923.

11 (6) Beginning on March 16, 2021, upon receipt of a notice from the department of the attorney general that an individual who has 12 been issued an enhanced driver license or enhanced official state 13 14 personal identification card under this act has been certified as a 15 program participant in the address confidentiality program, the 16 secretary of state shall issue a corrected enhanced driver license 17 or enhanced official state personal identification card to that 18 individual by mailing the license or card to his or her designated 19 address. An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state 20 personal identification card issued under this subsection or 21 subsection (1) to a program participant must display the 22 individual's designated address and must not display the 23 individual's residence address. The requirements of this subsection 24 are in addition to the requirements for individuals who are issued 25 a corrected standard driver license under section 310f of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.310f, or a corrected 26 27 official state personal identification card under section 2a of 28 1972 PA 222, MCL 28.292a.

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(7) As used in this section:



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(a) "Address confidentiality program" means a program as that
 term is defined in section 3 of the address confidentiality program
 act.

4 (b) "Designated address" means that term as defined in section 5 3 of the address confidentiality program act.

6 (c) "Program participant" means that term as defined in
7 section 3 of the address confidentiality program act.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 180 days9 after the date it is enacted into law.

10 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
11 unless Senate Bill No. 70 of the 100th Legislature is enacted into
12 law.



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
