- 1 Sec. 4. (1) This act does not apply to either of the 2 following:
 - (a) A transaction or conduct specifically authorized under laws administered by a regulatory board or officer acting under statutory authority of this state or the United States.
 - (b) An act done by the publisher, owner, agent, or employee of a newspaper, periodical, directory, radio or television
- station, or other communications medium in the publication or
- dissemination of an advertisement unless the publisher, owner,
- O agent, or employee knows or, under the circumstances, reasonably
- 11 should know of the false, misleading, or deceptive character of
