
In 1997 our daughter Kerrie was catastrophically injured in a Sunday afternoon auto accident. Suffering a Traumatic Brain Injury she was rendered a vent-dependent quadriplegic. She spent 1 year in a nursing home fighting constant illness, infection and harassment from other patients. She came home to a modified house and has spent the last 14 years with her family experiencing the best possible quality of life.

We did not have to file lawsuits or go in to bankruptcy to pay for her care – we have Michigan No-Fault Auto Insurance. Voted in to law by the people of the state of Michigan, this law has twice been challenged by change and subsequently rejected by a vote of the people.

It is most certainly a death sentence to those catastrophically injured to force them into a government run health care system by limiting or reducing their benefits over time.
