- **HB 4160 is a smart investment that will - almost immediately - more than pay for itself in new jobs and tax revenues for Michigan.**
- **A good investment returns a profit. Recent studies find that every \$1 invested into promotion generated from \$2.22 to as much as \$5.34 in new sales taxes to Michigan almost immediately.**
