Re: Installation of AMI Meter Letter Dated July 23, 2013

To Whom It May Concern:

Regarding your letter of July 23, 2013, returned herewith, notifying the electricity customer at 4451 Cypress Dr., Troy, MI 48085 of DTE's intent to install an advanced metering infrastructure (AMI) and or other Opt Out Device upon the building at the Oakland County address Cypress Drive - 4451 Troy Michigan.

It is a well-established fact that the AMI meters emit radiation far above safe levels and will thereby render the dwelling uninhabitable. The occupants of the referenced home are extremely sensitive to radiation. The people do not wish to risk the almost certain life-threatening effects of said poisoning by the installation of an AMI device.

Due to irrefutable facts concerning the safety and possible privacy violations and other yet to be discovered uses of the AMI (aka Smart Meter), be it known that DTE is hereby put on notice that the Executor Office for the William Michael Redfield, Estate, does not consent to installation of any style of new meter at the above referenced address. Concurrently, the customer refuses to accept any rate changes for future service.

Evidence of the above referenced health and privacy issues are well established facts. Should the need arise property owner(s) and occupants is /are prepared to produce such evidence.

The current meter serves the customer and DTE's needs which is to measure the amount of electrical use with very low amounts of electromagnetic radiation emanating from the device. There is no reason for a meter to serve any other function. If remote reading is a factor, safe fiber optic lines are available. In addition, the customer has previously notified DTE of this request and has offered to mail in power usage cards on a regularly scheduled & timely fashion.

Should DTE or any agent thereof attempt to install a new meter of any sort without the expressed written authorization by the Executor Office for the William Michael Redfield, Estate, all persons shall be construed as an Executor de son tort and subject to prosecution under the law.

This letter is being sent to inform you that the Michigan Public Service Commission ("MPSC") has approved DTE Electric Company's proposed plan to offer residential customers an opt-out of our Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Program.

Customers who choose to participate in the Opt-Out Program will have a non-transmitting (radio-off) digital meter installed.

Our records indicate that you expressed an interest in participating in the Opt-Out Program. If you would like to participate in this program, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be a residential customer
- Be the DTE Electric customer of record at the site address listed above
- Agree to pay the following fees:

**\$67.20 AMI Opt-Out Initial Fee**  
**\$9.80 AMI Opt-Out Monthly Charge**

These fees will be assessed for each site address participating in the Opt-Out Program.

Customers who participate in the Opt-Out Program will not receive the benefits that the advanced metering technology has to offer, such as:

- Access to your energy usage information
- Automatic power outage detection
- Fewer estimated bills
- Remote reading of your electric meter

Please contact us at **1-800-477-4747** if you wish to enroll in the Opt-Out Program. If you do not contact us to enroll in the program, we will proceed with the installation of the new advanced meter.
