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MINUTES

The Senate Committee on Education held a meeting on Tuesday, December 3, 2013 at 3:30 p.m. in the Senate Hearing Room, Ground Floor, Boji Tower.

Senator Pavlov called the meeting to order at 3:40 p.m.

Senator Pavlov announced the order of business for the Education Committee:

- Adoption of the minutes from the November 13, 2013 meeting
- SB 66 Sen. Proos Education; graduation requirements; Michigan merit curriculum; revise.

Senator Colbeck made a motion to adopt the minutes from the November 13, 2013 meeting; being no objection, the motion prevailed.

Senator Pavlov made a motion to excuse absent members; being no objection, the motion prevailed.

Senator Pavlov announced the next order of business would be Senate Bill 66, and advised members there was an S-1 version before them. Senator Proos gave members a brief overview of the bill and the changes in the S-1.
