SENATE COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION DRAFT MINUTES

The Senate Committee on Transportation held a meeting on Wednesday, November 12, 2014 at 12:00 p.m. in Room 100 of the Farnum Building.

Senator Casperson called the meeting to order at 12:46 p.m.

Senator Casperson announced the following order of business:

Adopt the minutes of the October 22, 2014 committee meeting

HB 5422 Rep. Lund Vehicles; registration; renewal deadline for vehicle registration; modify to provide a 120-day grace period.

HB 5714 Rep. McCready Transportation; carriers; motor carrier act; modify procedure for issuance of authority and other general revisions.

Senator Casperson led the members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Senator Hansen made a motion to adopt the minutes from the October 22, 2014 meeting; being no objection, the motion carried.

Senator Casperson announced House Bill 5422 was the next item on the agenda. Representative Lund gave members a brief overview of the bill.
