

June 12, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Wentworth, Lauwers, Victory, Vaupel, Alexander, Howell and Calley and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 246, entitled "Wolf-dog cross act,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 287.1002), as amended by 2016 PA 299.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

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- 2 (a) "Animal control officer" means a county animal control
- 3 officer as described in sections 29a and 29b of the dog law of
- 4 1919, 1919 PA 339, MCL 287.289a and 287.289b, or a city, village,
- 5 or township animal control officer as described in section 29c of
- 6 the dog law of 1919, 1919 PA 339, MCL 287.289c.
 - (b) "Animal control shelter" or "animal protection shelter"
- 8 means an animal control shelter or animal protection shelter,
- 9 respectively, registered with the department as prescribed under

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- 1 section 6 of 1969 PA 287, MCL 287.336.
- 2 (c) "Department" means the department of agriculture and rural
- 3 development.
- 4 (d) "Dog" means an animal of the species Canis familiaris or
- 5 Canis lupus familiaris.
- 6 (e) "Expert on wolf-dog cross identification" means an
- 7 individual who has, cumulatively, no fewer than 10 years of
- 8 training and field experience in wolf and wolf-dog cross behavioral
- 9 and morphological characteristics and who is recognized as an
- 10 expert at the state and national levels by others in the same
- 11 field.
- 12 (f) "Facility" means an indoor or outdoor cage, pen, or
- 13 similar enclosure where a wolf-dog cross is kept.
- 14 (g) "Law enforcement officer" means:
- 15 (i) A sheriff or sheriff's deputy.
- 16 (ii) A village or township marshal.
- 17 (iii) An officer of the police department of a city, village,
- 18 or township.
- (iv) An officer of the Michigan state police.
- 20 (v) A peace officer who is trained and licensed or certified
- 21 under the Michigan commission on law enforcement standards act,
- 22 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 to 28.615.
- (vi) A conservation officer appointed by the department of
- 24 natural resources.
- 25 (vii) An animal control officer.
- 26 (viii) A law enforcement officer of the federal government
- 27 authorized to enforce any federal law regulating animals.

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- 1 (h) "Livestock" means that term as defined in section 5-3 of
- 2 the animal industry act, 1988 PA 466, MCL 287.705.287.703.
- 3 (i) "Local unit" means a city, village, township, or county.
- 4 (j) "Permit" means a permit issued under section 4.
- 5 (k) "Permitting agency" means the agency of a local unit that
- 6 issues permits under section 4.
- 7 (l) "Person" means an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 8 association, governmental entity, or other legal entity.
- 9 (m) "Pet shop" means a pet shop licensed by the department as
- 10 prescribed under section 3 of 1969 PA 287, MCL 287.333.
- 11 (n) "Veterinarian" means a person licensed to practice
- 12 veterinary medicine under article 15 of the public health code,
- 13 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16101 to 333.18838.
- 14 (o) "Wolf" means an animal of the species Canis rufus or Canis
- 15 lupus, but does not include an animal of the species Canis lupus
- 16 familiaris.
- 17 (p) "Wolf-dog cross" means a canid resulting from the breeding
- 18 of any of the following:
- 19 (i) A wolf with a dog.
- 20 (ii) A wolf-dog cross with a wolf.
- 21 (iii) A wolf-dog cross with a dog.
- (iv) A wolf-dog cross with a wolf-dog cross.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 24 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 25 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 26 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 6205 (request no.
- 27 04193'17) of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.

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
