SUBSTITUTE FOR

SENATE BILL NO. 982

A bill to create the office of school safety and prescribe its powers and duties; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) The office of school safety is created within the
- 2 department of state police.
- 3 (2) The director of the department of state police shall
- 4 appoint the director of the office of school safety in accordance
- 5 with civil service procedures.
- 6 Sec. 3. (1) The office of school safety shall do all of the
- 7 following:
- 8 (a) In conjunction with the department of education, create
- 9 model practices for school safety, including, but not limited to,
- 10 engaging with local law enforcement agencies to assess school

- 1 buildings for which emergency operation plans are being developed.
- 2 (b) Develop and offer training to school staff on school
- 3 safety. The office of school safety may contract with another party
- 4 to develop and offer the training required under this subdivision.
- 5 (c) In conjunction with the department of education, seek and
- 6 apply for federal funds relating to school safety and reducing
- 7 violence and disruption in schools, including, but not limited to,
- 8 federal funding for alternative schools or programs described in
- 9 section 1280a of the revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL
- **10** 380.1280a.
- 11 (d) Create and administer a grant program to disburse
- 12 competitive school safety grants as appropriated by the legislature
- 13 to public schools, nonpublic schools, school districts, and
- 14 intermediate school districts to improve the safety and security of
- 15 school buildings, students, and staff.
- 16 (2) Subject to appropriation, the department of state police
- 17 shall provide the office of school safety with the staff and
- 18 resources necessary for the office to comply with this act.
- 19 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 20 date it is enacted into law.
