SENATE BILL No. 982

May 3, 2018, Introduced by Senator NOFS and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to create the office of school safety and prescribe its powers and duties; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. (1) The office of school safety is created within the
 department of state police.
- 3 (2) The director of the department of state police shall
- 4 appoint the director of the office of school safety in accordance
- 5 with civil service procedures.
 - Sec. 3. (1) The office of school safety shall do all of the following:
 - (a) In conjunction with the department of education, create

- 1 model practices for school safety, including, but not limited to,
- 2 engaging with local law enforcement agencies to assess school
- 3 buildings for which emergency operation plans are being developed.
- 4 (b) Develop and offer training to school staff on school
- 5 safety. The office of school safety may contract with another party
- 6 to develop and offer the training required under this subdivision.
- 7 (c) In conjunction with the department of education, seek and
- 8 apply for federal funds relating to school safety and reducing
- 9 violence and disruption in schools, including, but not limited to,
- 10 federal funding for alternative schools or programs.
- 11 (d) Create and administer a grant program to disburse
- 12 competitive school safety grants as appropriated by the legislature
- 13 to public schools, nonpublic schools, school districts, and
- 14 intermediate school districts to improve the safety and security of
- 15 school buildings, students, and staff.
- 16 (2) The department of state police shall provide the office of
- 17 school safety with the staff and resources necessary for the office
- 18 to comply with this act.
- 19 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 20 date it is enacted into law.
