## **SENATE BILL NO. 1149**

September 29, 2020, Introduced by Senators MACGREGOR, NESBITT, OUTMAN, VANDERWALL and SCHMIDT and referred to the Committee on Economic and Small Business Development.

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled "General sales tax act,"

(MCL 205.51 to 205.78) by adding section 4gg.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 4gg. (1) Beginning January 1, 2021, the sale of a fully
 automated consumer goods handling system or system parts to a
 wholesaler for fulfillment of orders to persons engaged in the
 business of making sales at retail of consumer goods is exempt from
 the tax under this act.

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(2) As used in this section:

2 (a) "Consumer goods" means finished goods for use primarily3 for personal, family, or household purposes.

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4 (b) "Fully automated consumer goods handling system" means a 5 fully automated, integrated goods handling system that separates, 6 sorts, temporarily stores, recombines, and assembles palletized 7 units of consumer goods and that occupies not less than 190,000 8 square feet of space in a facility owned, leased, or used by a 9 wholesaler.

10 (c) "System parts" means supply chain optimization machinery,
11 equipment, repair parts, and computer software that are component
12 parts of a fully automated consumer goods handling system.

13 (d) "Wholesaler" means a person that purchases consumer goods
14 from a manufacturer, producer, or other supplier and sells those
15 consumer goods to another person for sale at retail.
