8 Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for state
9 parks, the department of natural resources shall award funds to
10 nongovernment organizations to operate a statewide summer
11 employment program for at-risk youth and for returning veterans up
12 to age 27. Funding is provided to hire individuals for work that is
13 approved or managed by department employees.
