

SENATE BILL NO. 367

June 11, 2019, Introduced by Senator VANDERWALL and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending sections 43527a, 43528b, and 43532 (MCL 324.43527a, 324.43528b, and 324.43532), section 43527a as added and section 43528b as amended by 2013 PA 108 and section 43532 as amended by 2016 PA 463.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 43527a. (1) ~~Beginning March 1, 2014, only~~ **Only** an
2 individual holding a valid base license is eligible to purchase a
3 deer license or an antlerless deer license, pursuant to current

1 regulations. The fee for a deer license or an antlerless deer
2 license is \$20.00.

3 (2) ~~Beginning March 1, 2014, the~~ **The** department shall charge a
4 nonrefundable application fee not to exceed \$5.00 for each
5 individual who applies for an antlerless deer license.

6 (3) The department may issue a kill tag with or as part of
7 each deer license. The kill tag ~~shall~~ **must** bear the license number.
8 The kill tag may also include space for other pertinent information
9 required by the department. The kill tag, if issued, is part of the
10 license.

11 (4) Where authorized by the department, a resident may
12 purchase a second deer license for the fee assessed under this
13 ~~subsection~~ **section** for the deer license for which that individual
14 is eligible. However, a senior license discount is not available
15 for the purchase of a second deer license. ~~Where~~ **Except as**
16 **otherwise provided in this subsection, where** authorized by the
17 department, a nonresident may purchase an additional deer license
18 or antlerless deer license under this section for \$170.00. **Where**
19 **authorized by the department, a qualified nonresident may purchase**
20 **an additional deer license or antlerless deer license under this**
21 **section for \$85.00.** The department may issue orders under part 401
22 designating the kind of deer that may be taken and the geographic
23 area in which any license issued under this section is valid, when
24 advisable in managing deer.

25 Sec. 43528b. (1) An individual shall not hunt wolf without a
26 wolf hunting license. ~~Beginning March 1, 2014, only~~ **Only** an
27 individual holding a valid base license is eligible to purchase a
28 wolf hunting license. The fee for a resident wolf hunting license
29 is \$100.00. ~~The~~ **Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,**

1 **the** fee for a nonresident wolf hunting license is \$500.00. **For a**
2 **qualified nonresident, the fee for a nonresident wolf hunting**
3 **license is \$250.00.** The ~~department may establish a nonrefundable~~
4 ~~application fee not to exceed \$4.00 for each individual who applies~~
5 ~~for a wolf hunting license. Beginning March 1, 2014, the department~~
6 may establish a nonrefundable application fee not to exceed \$5.00
7 for each individual who applies for a wolf hunting license.

8 (2) The department may issue a kill tag with, or as part of, a
9 wolf hunting license. The kill tag ~~shall~~**must** bear the license
10 number. The kill tag may also include space for other pertinent
11 information required by the department. The kill tag, if issued, is
12 part of the license.

13 Sec. 43532. (1) An all-species fishing license entitles the
14 licensee to take and possess all aquatic species as prescribed by
15 law.

16 (2) An individual 17 years of age or older shall not take or
17 possess an aquatic species, except aquatic insects, in the waters
18 over which this state has jurisdiction without a license. The fee
19 for a resident all-species fishing license is \$25.00. ~~The~~**Except as**
20 **otherwise provided in this subsection, the** fee for a nonresident
21 all-species fishing license is ~~\$75.00.~~**\$68.00. For a qualified**
22 **nonresident, the fee for a nonresident all-species fishing license**
23 **is \$34.00.**

24 (3) ~~Not later than March 1, 2018, the~~**The** department shall
25 develop an electronic license that allows an individual to display
26 an electronic copy of his or her all-species fishing license using
27 an electronic device.

28 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
29 after the date it is enacted into law.

1 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
2 unless Senate Bill No. 366 of the 100th Legislature is enacted into
3 law.
