December 04, 2019, Introduced by Senator VANDERWALL and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 22203 (MCL 333.22203), as amended by 2002 PA $619\,.$

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 22203. (1) "Addition" means adding to a health facility

2 patient rooms, beds, and ancillary service areas, including, but 3 not limited to, procedure rooms or fixed equipment, surgical operating rooms, therapy rooms or fixed equipment, or other
 accommodations. to a health facility.

(2) "Capital expenditure" means an expenditure for a single 3 project, including cost of construction, engineering, and equipment 4 5 that under generally accepted accounting principles is not properly 6 chargeable as an expense of operation. Capital expenditure includes 7 a lease or comparable arrangement by or on behalf of a health 8 facility to obtain a health facility, licensed part of a health 9 facility, or equipment for a health facility, if the actual 10 purchase of a health facility, licensed part of a health facility, 11 or equipment for a health facility would have been considered a 12 capital expenditure under this part. Capital expenditure includes 13 the cost of studies, surveys, designs, plans, working drawings, 14 specifications, and other activities essential to the acquisition, 15 improvement, expansion, addition, conversion, modernization, new 16 construction, or replacement of physical plant and equipment.

17 (3) "Certificate of need" means a certificate issued under 18 this part authorizing a new health facility, a change in bed 19 capacity, the initiation, replacement, or expansion of a covered 20 clinical service, or a covered capital expenditure that is issued 21 in accordance with this part.

(4) "Certificate of need review standard" or "review standard"means a standard approved by the commission.

24 (5) "Change in bed capacity" means 1 or more of the following:25 (a) An increase in licensed hospital beds.

(b) An increase in licensed nursing home beds or hospital bedscertified for long-term care.

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(c) An increase in licensed psychiatric beds.

(c) (d) A change from 1 licensed use to a different licensed

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1 use.

2 (d) (e) The physical relocation of beds from a licensed site 3 to another geographic location.

4 (6) "Clinical" means directly pertaining to the diagnosis, treatment, or rehabilitation of an individual. 5

(7) "Clinical service area" means an area of a health 6 7 facility, including related corridors, equipment rooms, ancillary 8 service and support areas that house medical equipment, patient 9 rooms, patient beds, diagnostic, operating, therapy, or treatment 10 rooms or other accommodations related to the diagnosis, treatment, 11 or rehabilitation of individuals receiving services from the health 12 facility.

13 (8) "Commission" means the certificate of need commission 14 created under section 22211.

15 (9) "Covered capital expenditure" means a capital expenditure 16 of \$2,500,000.00 or more, as adjusted annually by the department 17 under section 22221(g), by a person for a health facility for a single project, excluding the cost of nonfixed medical equipment, 18 19 that includes or involves the acquisition, improvement, expansion, 20 addition, conversion, modernization, new construction, or replacement of a clinical service area. 21

(10) "Covered clinical service", except as modified by the 22 23 commission under section 22215, means 1 or more of the following:

(a) Initiation or expansion of 1 or more of the following 24 25 services:

(i) Neonatal intensive care services or special newborn nursing 26 27 services.

28 (*ii*) Open heart surgery.

29 (iii) Extrarenal organ transplantation.

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- 1 (b) Initiation, replacement, or expansion of 1 or more of the 2 following services:
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(*i*) Extracorporeal shock wave lithotripsy.

4 (*ii*) Megavoltage radiation therapy.

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(iii) Positron emission tomography.

6 (*iv*) Surgical services provided in a freestanding surgical
7 outpatient facility, an ambulatory surgery center certified under
8 title XVIII, or a surgical department of a hospital licensed under
9 part 215 and offering inpatient or outpatient surgical services.

10 (v) Cardiac catheterization.

11 (vi) Fixed and mobile magnetic resonance imager services.

12 (vii) Fixed and mobile computerized tomography scanner
13 services.

14 (*viii*) Air ambulance services.

15 (c) Initiation or expansion of a specialized psychiatric
16 program for children and adolescent patients utilizing licensed
17 psychiatric beds.

18 (c) (d) Initiation, replacement, or expansion of a service not
19 listed in this subsection, but designated as a covered clinical
20 service by the commission under section 22215(1)(a).

(11) "Fixed equipment" means equipment that is affixed to and constitutes a structural component of a health facility, including, but not limited to, mechanical or electrical systems, elevators, generators, pumps, boilers, and refrigeration equipment.
