

SENATE BILL NO. 691

December 11, 2019, Introduced by Senators SCHMIDT and HORN and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled
"Occupational code,"
by amending section 1108 (MCL 339.1108), as amended by 2014 PA 136.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1108. (1) The department shall issue a license to
2 practice as a barber to an individual who fulfills all of the
3 following requirements:

4 (a) Is not less than 17 years of age.

1 (b) Is of good moral character.

2 (c) Demonstrates satisfactory completion of ~~not either of the~~
3 **following:**

4 (i) **Not** less than a 1,800-hour course of study at a licensed
5 barber college.

6 (ii) **Subject to subsection (4), a barber apprenticeship.**

7 (d) Passes an examination approved by the board and the
8 department.

9 (e) Has completed the tenth grade of school or has an
10 equivalent education as determined by the department.

11 (2) The department shall issue a license as a barber to an
12 individual who has held a license as a barber in another state,
13 jurisdiction, or country for 1 out of the 3 years immediately
14 preceding the date of application if the requirements for licensure
15 in the other state, jurisdiction, or country are substantially
16 equivalent to the requirements of subsection (1), as determined by
17 the department. ~~However, the~~ **The** department may deny or limit a
18 license **described in this subsection** if the applicant has been
19 disciplined, or disciplinary action is pending, in another state,
20 jurisdiction, or country.

21 (3) For the purposes of fulfilling the requirement of
22 subsection ~~(1)(c), (1)(c)(i)~~, an individual whose instruction as a
23 barber was received in another state, jurisdiction, or country may
24 substitute experience as a barber or barber apprentice for
25 instruction in the ratio of 3 months of experience for 100 hours of
26 instruction. ~~However, if his or her~~ **If the individual's** experience
27 as a barber or barber apprentice was acquired in a country that the
28 department considers a country from which records are not generally
29 available, both of the following apply to the substitution of

1 experience for instruction under this subsection:

2 (a) ~~He or she~~ **The individual** may not substitute experience for
 3 instruction under this subsection unless he or she provides a
 4 signed and notarized attestation detailing his or her experience,
 5 including his or her place of employment or apprenticeship, to the
 6 department.

7 (b) ~~He or she~~ **The individual** may not substitute experience for
 8 any of the hours of instruction concerning safety and sanitation,
 9 or concerning laws, rules, and regulations, required by the
 10 department by rules promulgated under this article.

11 **(4) A barber apprenticeship does not satisfy the requirements**
 12 **of subsection (1) (c) (ii) unless it includes at least a total of**
 13 **2,000 hours of on-the-job training in all of the following areas**
 14 **for the approximate hours listed below:**

15 (a) A total of at least 550 hours of haircutting, male and
 16 female. The 550 hours required under this subdivision must include,
 17 at a minimum, each of the following:

18 (i) 150 hours of regular taper cutting, male.

19 (ii) 350 hours of hairstyling male, female, and children.

20 (iii) 50 hours of shaving and beard trimming.

21 (b) A total of at least 50 hours of facials, male and female.

22 (c) A total of at least 50 hours of shampooing and scalp
 23 treatments.

24 (d) A total of at least 450 hours of permanent waving. The 450
 25 hours required under this subdivision must include, at a minimum,
 26 each of the following:

27 (i) 150 hours of regular perms.

28 (ii) 50 hours of partial perms.

29 (iii) 100 hours of stac perms.

1 (iv) 150 hours of natural perm curl.

2 (e) A total of at least 300 hours of coloring hair, male and
3 female. The 300 hours required under this subdivision must include,
4 at a minimum, each of the following:

5 (i) 150 hours of full color.

6 (ii) 50 hours of highlighting.

7 (iii) 50 hours of bleaching complete.

8 (iv) 50 hours of frosting.

9 (f) A total of at least 50 hours of hair relaxing.

10 (g) A total of at least 250 hours of hair pieces. The 50 hours
11 required under this subdivision must include, at a minimum, each of
12 the following:

13 (i) 100 hours of selling.

14 (ii) 75 hours of fitting both types, plaster of paris and tape.

15 (iii) 50 hours of styling and cutting.

16 (iv) 50 hours of maintaining upkeep.

17 (h) A total of at least 125 hours of shop management. The 125
18 hours required under this subdivision must include, at a minimum,
19 each of the following:

20 (i) Bookkeeping.

21 (ii) Psychology of working with people.

22 (iii) Tax service.

23 (iv) Stock, supply equipment inventory.

24 (i) A total of at least 100 hours of professional ethics.
