

MICHIGAN ELECTION LAW (EXCERPT)
Act 116 of 1954

168.500c Issuance of voter identification card; effect of returning card as nondeliverable.

Sec. 500c. The clerk of a city or township, upon receiving an application for registration from an applicant the clerk determines to be qualified as an elector, shall forward to the applicant a voter identification card as provided in section 499. A person to whom the voter identification card is sent shall be registered for all elections, including village elections, upon its receipt. A voter identification card returned by the post office as nondeliverable shall be attached to the application by the clerk, and the person shall be deemed not registered under this act.
