- prohibit probate judges from exercising their powers to perform
  marriages as provided by Act No. 180 of the Public Acts of 1897,
  being sections 551.201 to 551.204 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
  - (2) This section applies to a marriage entered into on or after the effective date of the amendatory act that added this subsection.
