A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4005 AS INTRODUCED 1-11-95

House Bill 4005 would amend sections of the Michigan Liquor Control Act pertaining to brewpubs. A "brewpub" is defined as a license that is issued to an establishment in conjunction with certain other liquor licenses (such as a class "C" or tavern license) that allow the licensee to manufacture and sell beer at the licensed premises. The bill would increase the allowable amount of beer to be brewed and sold at the licensed premises from 2,000 to 4,000 barrels of beer in a year and would delete a requirement that the beer is to be sold for consumption on the premises only. In addition, the bill would delete a provision prohibiting a person from having an interest, whether directly or indirectly, in more than one brewpub.
