A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4200 AS INTRODUCED 1-30-95

The bill would amend the Michigan Legislative Retirement System Act to conform to the provisions of the Eligible Domestic Relations Order Act (Public Act 46 of 1991), which requires that benefits payable under public employee retirement systems be subject to eligible domestic relations orders (EDROs) in relation to child support, alimony, or marital property rights. Further, current law specifies that if an award or order by a court for alimony or child support requires the retirement system to withhold or make payments of benefits in order to meet a person's alimony or child support obligations, only those amounts as they come payable to the retiree can be used. The bill would make an exception to this provision if so ordered by a court under the Eligible Domestic Relations Order Act.
