LOTTERY PRINTING EXCEPTION

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4474 AS INTRODUCED 2-28-95

Public Act 153 of 1937 requires that all printing for which the state is charged, or pays for, except printing for primary school districts, counties, townships, cities, villages, or legal publications ordered by or for elected state officers, must be printed within the state and, with certain exceptions, bear the label of the branch of the allied printing trades council of the locality in which the printing is done. The bill would exempt printing for the Bureau of the Lottery, in the Department of Treasury, from the requirements of the act.
