A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5123 AS INTRODUCED 9-26-95

The Michigan Vehicle Code currently provides that the maximum speed limit on all highways or parts of highways is generally 55 miles per hour unless federal law permits a maximum speed limit of 65 miles per hour, in which case the speed limit is 65 miles per hour. The bill would delete language that allows the state to set the maximum speed limit at 65 miles per hour only if federal law allows for this, and would establish the maximum speed limit on all freeways in the state at 65 miles per hour.
