# ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 4598

AN ACT to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, entitled "An act to protect the environment and natural resources of the state; to codify, revise, consolidate, and classify laws relating to the environment and natural resources of the state; to regulate the discharge of certain substances into the environment; to regulate the use of certain lands, waters, and other natural resources of the state; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and officials; to provide for certain charges, fees, and assessments; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; to repeal certain parts of this act on a specific date; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," being sections 324.101 to 324.90101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 11115b.

*The People of the State of Michigan enact:*

Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, being sections 324.101 to 324.90101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 11115b to read as follows:

Sec. 11115b. Corrective actions conducted pursuant to this part satisfy a person's remedial action obligations under part 201 and remedial obligations under part 31 for that release or threat of release.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
