ENROLLED HOUSE BILL No. 5650

AN ACT to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, entitled "An act to protect the environment and natural resources of the state; to codify, revise, consolidate, and classify laws relating to the environment and natural resources of the state; to regulate the discharge of certain substances into the environment; to regulate the use of certain lands, waters, and other natural resources of the state; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and officials; to provide for certain charges, fees, and assessments; to prescribe penalties and provide remedies; to repeal certain parts of this act on a specific date; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts," as amended, being sections 324.101 to 324.90106 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 62506a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, as amended, being sections 324.101 to 324.90106 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 62506a to read as follows:

Sec. 62506a. (1) As used in this section:

(a) "Hazardous waste", "storage facility", and "treatment facility" have the meanings ascribed to these terms in part 111.

(b) "Multisource commercial hazardous waste disposal well" means a disposal well that receives hazardous waste that is generated by more than 1 person. Multisource commercial hazardous waste disposal well does not include a disposal well that receives hazardous waste generated from a subsidiary of the person that owns or operates a hazardous waste disposal well.

(c) "Person" includes a governmental entity.

(2) Prior to the drilling of a multisource commercial hazardous waste disposal well or the conversion of a well to a multisource commercial hazardous waste disposal well, a person shall have obtained a construction permit for an on-site treatment facility and storage facility under section 11118.

(3) Nothing in the amendatory act that added this section shall be construed to abrogate common law.

Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless Senate Bill No. 891 of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
