ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 546

AN ACT to amend section 8125 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended "An act to revise and consolidate the statutes relating to the organization and jurisdiction of the courts of this state; the powers and duties of such courts, and of the judges and other officers thereof; the forms and attributes of civil claims and actions; the time within which civil actions and proceedings may be brought in said courts; pleading, evidence, practice and procedure in civil and criminal actions and proceedings in said courts; to provide remedies and penalties for the violation of certain provisions of this act; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with, or contravening any of the provisions of this act," as amended by Act No. 135 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 600.8125 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Section 1. Section 8125 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, as amended by Act No. 135 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 600.8125 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 8125. (1) The fifty-fourth-a district consists of the city of Lansing, is a district of the third class, and has the following number of judges:

(a) Through December 31, 1995, 6 judges.

(b) Beginning January 1, 1996, 5 judges.

(2) The fifty-fourth-b district consists of the city of East Lansing, is a district of the third class, and has 2 judges.

(3) The fifty-fifth district consists of the county of Ingham except the cities of Lansing and East Lansing, is a district of the second class, and has 2 judges.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
