



HOUSE BILL No. 4298

February 2, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Gnodtke, Randall, Llewellyn, Green and Anthony and referred to the Committee on Agriculture and Forestry.

A bill to amend the title of Act No. 426 of the Public Acts of 1988, entitled

"An act to regulate dangerous animals; to provide for the confinement, tattooing, or destruction of dangerous animals; and to provide penalties for the owners or keepers of dangerous animals that attack human beings,"

being sections 287.321 to 287.323 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 2a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. The title of Act No. 426 of the Public Acts of
2 1988, being sections 287.321 to 287.323 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended and section 2a is added to read as follows:

4 TITLE

5 An act to regulate dangerous animals AND THE CONTENT OF
6 LOCAL ORDINANCES IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; to provide for the
7 confinement, tattooing, or destruction of dangerous animals; and

1 to provide penalties for the owners or keepers of dangerous
2 animals that attack human beings.

3 SEC. 2A. A COUNTY, CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP SHALL NOT
4 ADOPT OR ENFORCE AN ORDINANCE THAT REGULATES OR PROHIBITS THE
5 POSSESSION OF AN ANIMAL BASED EXCLUSIVELY ON THE BREED OF THE
6 ANIMAL.
