



# HOUSE BILL No. 4810

May 10, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Hill, Rhead, Horton, Fitzgerald, Walberg, Ryan, DeLange, Whyman, Voorhees, Perricone, Bush, Lowe, Crissman, Gernaat, Sikkema and Jellema and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend chapter IX of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of 1927, entitled as amended

"The code of criminal procedure,"

as amended, being sections 769.1 to 769.28 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 29.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Chapter IX of Act No. 175 of the Public Acts of  
2 1927, as amended, being sections 769.1 to 769.28 of the Michigan  
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 29 to read as  
4 follows:

### 5 CHAPTER IX

6 SEC. 29. A JUDGE OF A COURT HAVING JURISDICTION, WHEN PRO-  
7 NOUNCING JUDGMENT AGAINST AND PASSING SENTENCE UPON A PERSON  
8 CONVICTED OF OR WHO ENTERS A NOLO CONTENDERE PLEA ACCEPTED BY THE  
9 COURT FOR A FELONY ARISING OUT OF THE PERSON'S SERVICE AS A

1 PUBLIC EMPLOYEE AS DEFINED IN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT  
2 BENEFITS FORFEITURE ACT, ACT NO. 350 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1994,  
3 BEING SECTIONS 38.2701 TO 38.2705 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS,  
4 SHALL ORDER THE PERSON'S PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR-  
5 FEITED PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR-  
6 FEITURE ACT, ACT NO. 350 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1994. THE COURT  
7 SHALL PREPARE AN ORDER THAT COMPLIES WITH THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE  
8 RETIREMENT BENEFITS FORFEITURE ACT, ACT NO. 350 OF THE PUBLIC  
9 ACTS OF 1994.
