



HOUSE BILL No. 5017

September 12, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Bryant and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend section 10 of Act No. 187 of the Public Acts of 1990, entitled "The pupil transportation act," being section 257.1810 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 10 of Act No. 187 of the Public Acts of
2 1990, being section 257.1810 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 10. (1) Each ~~motor vehicle~~ SCHOOL BUS owned by a
5 public, private, or governmental agency and operated for the
6 transportation of passengers to or from school and school related
7 events shall meet or exceed the passenger protection federal
8 motor vehicle safety standards applicable to the construction and
9 sale of that vehicle. A ~~vehicle~~ SCHOOL BUS for which there are
10 no applicable passenger protection federal motor vehicle safety

1 standards shall not be used to transport passengers to and from
2 school and school related events.

3 ~~(2) Vehicles, other than school buses, shall meet the~~
4 ~~requirements of this section by October 1, 1997.~~

5 (2) ~~(3)~~ A school shall not purchase a ~~vehicle~~ SCHOOL BUS
6 to be used to transport passengers to and from school and school
7 related events that does not meet or exceed the passenger protec-
8 tion federal motor vehicle safety standards applicable to that
9 vehicle. A school shall not purchase a ~~vehicle~~ SCHOOL BUS to
10 be used to transport passengers to and from school and school
11 related events for which there are no applicable passenger pro-
12 tection federal motor vehicle safety standards. ~~This subsection~~
13 ~~shall apply to vehicles, other than school buses, purchased on or~~
14 ~~after October 1, 1993.~~

15 ~~(4) Vehicles used by parents or a parent's designee to~~
16 ~~transport their children to and from school and school related~~
17 ~~events under contract with the school are exempt from the~~
18 ~~requirements of this section.~~
