



HOUSE BILL No. 5037

September 13, 1995, Introduced by Rep. Nye and referred to the Committee on House Oversight and Ethics.

A bill to establish the office of the federal legislation mandate ombudsman; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. There is created in the executive office of the
2 governor the office of the federal legislation mandate
3 ombudsman.

4 Sec. 2. The office of the federal legislation mandate
5 ombudsman shall do all of the following:

6 (a) Coordinate a systematic effort in each agency of this
7 state to monitor and report the cost to this state of federal
8 legislation mandate.

9 (b) Track, forecast, disseminate, and distribute information
10 regarding federal legislation mandates.

1 (c) Annually report to the legislature concerning the
2 matters that are listed in this section.

3 Sec. 3. As used in this act, "agency" means that word as
4 defined in section 3 of the administrative procedures act of
5 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of 1969, being section
6 24.203 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
