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## HOUSE BILL No. 5120

A bill to amend section 3 of Act No. 102 of the Public Acts

of 1986, entitled

"An act to establish a grant program for certain part-time, independent students in this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and institutions of higher education,"

being section 390.1283 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Act No. 102 of the Public Acts of

2 1986, being section 390.1283 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is

3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3. A person is eligible to participate in the grant5 program if he or she:

- 6 (a) Is a part-time student.
- 7 (b) Is an independent student.

(c) Has not been enrolled in a high school diploma program
 other than general educational development (GED) or adult
 education for at least the 2 preceding years.

4 (d) Is enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an undergradu5 ate program of not less than 9 months duration leading to a
6 degree or certificate from a Michigan degree granting educational
7 institution that is approved by the state board of education AND
8 THAT IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE MICHIGAN CAMPUS SEXUAL ASSAULT
9 INFORMATION ACT.

(e) Has resided continuously in this state for the immedi11 ately preceding 12 months and is not considered a resident of any
12 other state.

13 (f) Is not incarcerated in a corrections institution.

14 (g) Has complied with this act and the rules promulgated15 under this act by the authority.

16 (h) Is a United States citizen or permanent resident.

17 (i) Is not enrolled in a program leading to a degree in the-18 ology or divinity.

19 (j) Is not in default on a loan guaranteed by the 20 authority.

21 (k) Is shown by the school to be making satisfactory aca-22 demic progress.

23 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless

25 no. 00189'95) of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.

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
