

HOUSE BILL No. 5185

October 3, 1995, Introduced by Reps. Agee, Prusi, Scott, Brewer, LaForge, Stallworth, Hanley, Martinez, Wallace, Parks, Cherry, Schroer, DeHart, Pitoniak, Oxender and Wetters and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to amend the title of Act No. 348 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled

"An act to regulate relationships between landlords and tenants relative to rental agreements for rental units; to regulate the payment, repayment, use and investment of security deposits; to provide for commencement and termination inventories of rental units; to provide for termination arrangements relative to rental units; to provide for legal remedies; and to provide penalties,"

as amended, being sections 554.601 to 554.616 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 15a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. The title of Act No. 348 of the Public Acts of

- 14 KNOWLEDGEABLE ABOUT LANDLORD-TENANT MATTERS.
