

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5508**

January 16, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Leland, Vaughn, Murphy, Harder, Pitoniak, DeMars, Brewer, Baird and Cherry and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes.

A bill to amend section 16902a of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, entitled

"Natural resources and environmental protection act," being section 324.16902a of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 16902a of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1994, being section 324.16902a of the Michigan Compiled Laws,
- 3 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 16902a. (1) A retailer who receives scrap tires in
- 5 this state shall dispose of the scrap tires at a registered scrap
- 6 tire collection site, at a licensed landfill, or by contracting
- 7 with a scrap tire hauler who is registered pursuant to section
- 8 16905. A RETAILER WHO RECEIVES SCRAP TIRES SHALL NOT CHARGE FOR
- 9 THE RECEIPT OF THOSE SCRAP TIRES AN AMOUNT GREATER THAN THE
- 10 RETAILER'S COSTS FOR THE DISPOSAL OF THE SCRAP TIRES.

1 (2) A retailer shall maintain records indicating the number
2 of scrap tires and the final disposition of scrap tires disposed
3 of under subsection (1). These records shall be maintained for a
4 period of 5 years and shall be made available, upon request, to
5 the department or to a law enforcement officer at reasonable
6 hours.
