A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956,

entitled as amended

"The insurance code of 1956,"

as amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 3406f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, as
 amended, being sections 500.100 to 500.8302 of the Michigan
 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 3406f to read as
 follows:

5 SEC. 3406F. (1) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1997, AN INSURER THAT 6 DELIVERS, ISSUES FOR DELIVERY, OR RENEWS IN THIS STATE AN 7 EXPENSE-INCURRED HOSPITAL, SURGICAL, OR MEDICAL POLICY OR 8 CERTIFICATE THAT OFFERS DEPENDENT COVERAGE SHALL PROVIDE OR OFFER 9 TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPENDENT COVERAGE APPLICABLE TO CHILDREN INCLUDE COVERAGE FOR VACCINES TO IMMUNIZE AGAINST THE DISEASES
 AND INFECTIONS LISTED IN SECTION 9202 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE,
 ACT NO. 368 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING SECTION 333.9202 OF
 THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, AND SHALL PROVIDE OR OFFER TO PROVIDE
 FOR COVERAGE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE VACCINES FROM THE
 MOMENT OF BIRTH OR PLACEMENT FOR ADOPTION THROUGH THE AGE OF 36
 MONTHS.

8 (2) COVERAGE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY
9 COPAYMENTS, COINSURANCE PROVISIONS, DEDUCTIBLES, OR DOLLAR
10 LIMITS, AND THIS EXEMPTION SHALL BE EXPLICITLY PROVIDED FOR IN
11 THE POLICY OR CERTIFICATE.

12 (3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO LIMITED CLASSIFICATION13 POLICIES.

14 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "LIMITED CLASSIFICATION
15 POLICIES" MEANS AN ACCIDENT ONLY POLICY OR CERTIFICATE, A LIMITED
16 ACCIDENT POLICY OR CERTIFICATE, OR A SPECIFIED DISEASE POLICY OR
17 CERTIFICATE.
