



HOUSE BILL No. 5620

February 22, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Ryan, Hill, Whyman, Kaza, Weeks, Gernaat, Bullard, Geiger, Green, Jaye, Byl, Llewellyn, Law, London, Perricone, Randall, Oxender, Jellema, McBryde, DeMars, Bush, Dobb, Nye, Galloway, Gnodtke and Jersevic and referred to the Committee on Public Utilities.

A bill to amend Act No. 118 of the Public Acts of 1893,
entitled as amended

"An act to revise and consolidate the laws relative to state prisons, to state houses of correction, and branches of state prisons and reformatories, and the government and discipline thereof and to repeal all acts inconsistent therewith,"

as amended, being sections 800.33 to 800.61 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 43.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 118 of the Public Acts of 1893, as
2 amended, being sections 800.33 to 800.61 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 43 to read as follows:

4 SEC. 43. (1) A PRISONER SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO HAVE IN HIS
5 OR HER CELL ANY PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT REQUIRES THE USE OF ELEC-
6 TRICITY UNLESS THE PRISONER PAYS AN ELECTRICAL USAGE FEE TO THE
7 DEPARTMENT AT A RATE OF \$3.00 PER MONTH.

1 (2) A FEE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE COLLECTED
2 FROM THE PRISONER'S INSTITUTIONAL ACCOUNT ANNUALLY OR AT OTHER
3 INTERVALS AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
