as amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 1149a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1149a to read as
follows:

5 SEC. 1149A. A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL PROVIDE SPECIAL ASSIST-6 ANCE TO EACH PUPIL ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT WHO IS ELIGI-7 BLE FOR PURPOSES OF ALLOCATING FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER CHAPTER 1 OF 8 THE HAWKINS-STAFFORD ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT 9 AMENDMENTS OF 1988, PUBLIC LAW 100-297, OR WHO IS AT RISK OF FALLING SERIOUSLY BEHIND OTHERS OF HIS OR HER AGE LEVEL IN
LEARNING OR IN DANGER OF BEING EXPELLED OR OF NOT ADVANCING IN
GRADE LEVEL WITH PUPILS OF HIS OR HER AGE LEVEL, AS DEFINED BY
DEPARTMENT RULE. A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL AVOID REMOVING A.PUPIL
DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION FROM HIS OR HER CORE CURRICULUM OR
OTHER REGULAR CLASSROOM COURSES IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THE SPECIAL
ASSISTANCE.
