



# HOUSE BILL No. 5819

April 25, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Whyman, DeMars, Anthony, Horton, Goschka, Kaza, Walberg, Dalman, Tesanovich, DeHart, Lowe, Jaye, Cropsey, McBryde, Kukuk, Sikkema, Gernaat and Green and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A bill to amend section 40111 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1994, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," as added by Act No. 57 of the Public Acts of 1995, being section 324.40111 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Section 40111 of Act No. 451 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1994, as added by Act No. 57 of the Public Acts of 1995, being  
3 section 324.40111 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 Sec. 40111. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this part  
6 or in a department order authorized under section 40107, a person  
7 shall not take an animal from in or upon a vehicle.

1 ~~(2) Except as otherwise provided in this part or in a~~  
2 ~~department order authorized under section 40107, a person shall~~  
3 ~~not transport or have in possession a firearm in or upon a vehi-~~  
4 ~~cle, unless the firearm is unloaded in both barrel and magazine~~  
5 ~~and enclosed in a case, carried in the trunk of a vehicle, or~~  
6 ~~unloaded in a motorized boat.~~

7 ~~(3) Except as otherwise provided in this part, a person~~  
8 ~~shall not transport or have in possession a bow in or upon a~~  
9 ~~vehicle, unless the bow is unstrung, enclosed in a case, or car-~~  
10 ~~ried in the trunk of a vehicle.~~

11 (2) ~~(4)~~ A person shall not hunt or discharge a firearm  
12 within 150 yards of an occupied building, dwelling, house, resi-  
13 dence, or cabin, or any barn or other building used in connection  
14 with a farm operation, without obtaining the written permission  
15 of the owner, renter, or occupant of the property.
