

## SENATE BILL No. 103

January 17, 1995, Introduced by Senator SHUGARS and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Senior Citizens.

A bill to amend Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1984, entitled

"Third party administrator act,"

being sections 550.901 to 550.962 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 33.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1984, being
- 2 sections 550.901 to 550.962 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended by adding section 33 to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 33. (1) A THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATOR SHALL INCLUDE IN
- 5 18-POINT TYPE IN EACH NOTICE OR STATEMENT OF EXPLANATION OF COV-
- 6 ERAGE OR BENEFITS PROVIDED TO A COVERED INDIVIDUAL THE FOLLOWING
- 7 STATEMENT:
- 8 "THE MAXIMUM FEE ALLOWANCE USED TO DETERMINE
- 9 REIMBURSEMENT OR PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNTS CHARGED

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1	BY YOUR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER IS BASED ON FEE
2	DATA THAT WAS LAST REVISED ON [DATE OF LAST
3	REVISION], AND WAS DETERMINED BASED UPON
4	[DESCRIBE SOURCE OF FEE DATA AND TIME PERIOD FOR

- 5 WHICH DATA WAS COLLECTED].".
- 7 TOR HAS FAILED TO PROVIDE THE STATEMENT TO A COVERED INDIVIDUAL

(2) IF THE COMMISSIONER FINDS THAT A THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRA-

- 8 AS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE COMMISSIONER MAY ORDER THE
- 9 THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATOR, AFTER AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING
- 10 PURSUANT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, ACT
- 11 NO. 306 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1969, BEING SECTIONS 24.201 TO
- 12 24.328 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, TO PAY A CIVIL FINE OF NOT
- 13 MORE THAN \$50.00 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
