

## **SENATE BILL No. 153**

January 31, 1995, Introduced by Senator STALLINGS and referred to the Committee on Families, Mental Health and Human Services.

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 411r.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as
 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled
 Laws, is amended by adding section 411r to read as follows:
 SEC. 411R. (1) A CHILD'S CUSTODIAL PARENT WHO INTENTIONALLY
 OBSTRUCTS VISITATION WITH THE CHILD BY THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT AS
 PROVIDED FOR IN A COURT ISSUED VISITATION ORDER IS GUILTY OF A
 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS
 OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.

(2) IT IS A COMPLETE DEFENSE TO A PROSECUTION UNDER THIS
 SECTION IF THE DEFENDANT PROVES BY CLEAR AND CONVINCING EVIDENCE
 THAT ALLOWING VISITATION WITH THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT WOULD
 SUBJECT THE CHILD TO A SUBSTANTIALLY INCREASED RISK OF PHYSICAL
 OR PSYCHOLOGICAL HARM.

6 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CHILD" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL
7 UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE WHO IS NOT EMANCIPATED AS PROVIDED IN ACT
8 NO. 293 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1968, BEING SECTIONS 722.1 TO 722.6
9 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS.
