

SENATE BILL No. 328

February 23, 1995, Introduced by Senator GAST and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the legislature, the judiciary, the executive, the department of attorney general, the department of state, the department of treasury, the department of management and budget, the department of civil service, the department of civil rights, and certain state purposes related thereto for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the state agencies; and to declare the effect of this act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the legislature, the judiciary, 2 the executive, the department of attorney general, the department of 3 state, the department of treasury, the department of management and 4 budget, the department of civil service, the department of civil rights, 5 and certain state purposes related thereto, for the fiscal year ending 6 September 30, 1996, from the following funds:

In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of arti-3 cle IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state 4 resources in this appropriations act for the fiscal year ending 5 September 30, 1996 is \$______ and state appropriations paid to 6 units of local government are 0.

The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under 8 this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs 9 for which appropriations are made under this act are subject to Act 10 No. 431 of the Public Acts of 1984, being sections 18.1101 to 18.1594 of 11 the Michigan Compiled Laws.
