



SENATE BILL No. 528

May 16, 1995, Introduced by Senator BERRYMAN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled as amended

"The Michigan penal code,"

as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 411r.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 411r to read as follows:

4 SEC. 411R. (1) A PERSON WHO RECKLESSLY ENGAGES IN CONDUCT
5 THAT CREATES A SUBSTANTIAL RISK OF DEATH TO ANOTHER PERSON UNDER
6 CIRCUMSTANCES EVINCING A DEPRAVED INDIFFERENCE TO HUMAN LIFE IS
7 GUILTY OF FIRST DEGREE RECKLESS ENDANGERMENT, A FELONY PUNISHABLE
8 BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE
9 THAN \$2,000.00, OR BOTH.

1 (2) A PERSON WHO RECKLESSLY ENGAGES IN CONDUCT THAT CREATES
2 A SUBSTANTIAL RISK OF SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON
3 IS GUILTY OF SECOND DEGREE RECKLESS ENDANGERMENT, A MISDEMEANOR
4 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF
5 NOT MORE THAN \$100.00, OR BOTH.
