



SENATE BILL No. 1042

May 21, 1996, Introduced by Senator ROGERS and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 84 of the Public Acts of 1949, entitled

"An act to provide for transfers of inmates of certain state institutions and agencies to other state institutions and agencies for the purpose of receiving care and training,"

as amended by Act No. 74 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section 720.601 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 84 of the Public Acts of
2 1949, as amended by Act No. 74 of the Public Acts of 1988, being
3 section 720.601 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 1. A person who has been committed by the probate
6 court OR THE FAMILY DIVISION OF CIRCUIT COURT or a court of
7 general criminal jurisdiction to an institution or agency of the
8 state which is authorized to receive juveniles under the

1 direction of the FORMER department of mental health, THE
2 DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH, THE department of corrections,
3 ~~or~~ the FORMER department of social services, OR THE FAMILY
4 INDEPENDENCE AGENCY for the purpose of treatment, or training, or
5 both, may be transferred from that institution to any other
6 institution or agency of the state, if it appears to the satis-
7 faction of the superintendent of the institution to which the
8 person has been committed that the person will substantially ben-
9 efit from the care and training in the other institution or
10 facility and that the interests of the person and of the state
11 will be best served thereby.

12 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
13 House Bill No. 5158 of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
