



SENATE BILL No. 1091

July 3, 1996, Introduced by Senator A. SMITH and referred
to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend Act No. 472 of the Public Acts of 1978,
entitled

"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate lobbyists,
lobbyist agents, and lobbying activities; to require registration
of lobbyists and lobbyist agents; to require the filing of
reports; to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of
state; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and
parts of acts,"

as amended, being sections 4.411 to 4.431 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws, by adding section 6b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Act No. 472 of the Public Acts of 1978, as
amended, being sections 4.411 to 4.431 of the Michigan Compiled
Laws, is amended by adding section 6b to read as follows:

SEC. 6B. (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON REGISTERED
AS A LOBBYIST AGENT UNDER THIS ACT SHALL SUPPLY A LIST OF THE
PERSON'S LOBBYING CLIENTS TO PROSPECTIVE LOBBYING CLIENTS AND

1 SHALL INFORM EXISTING LOBBYING CLIENTS AS TO THE ADDITION OF A
2 NEW LOBBYING CLIENT.

3 (2) IN SUPPLYING A LIST OF EXISTING LOBBYING CLIENTS OR THE
4 NAME OF A NEW LOBBYING CLIENT, THE LOBBYIST AGENT SHALL PROVIDE
5 ONLY ORGANIZATIONAL NAMES AND NOT THE NAME OF ANY INDIVIDUAL
6 MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION WHICH THE LOBBYIST AGENT REPRESENTS.
