



HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION E

January 30, 1995, Introduced by Reps. London, Goschka, Jersevic, Bush, Kukuk, Hill, Bodem, Whyman, Gilmer, Gernaat, Gnodtke, Ryan, Rhead, Voorhees, Law, Harder, Baade, Porreca, McNutt, Bullard, Perricone, McBryde, Dalman, Nye, Brackenridge, Palamara, Randall, Alley, Munsell, Johnson, Oxender, LeTarte and Horton and referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Civil Rights.

A joint resolution to petition the congress of the United States to adopt an amendment to the constitution of the United States, for submission to the states, to require, with certain exceptions, that the total of all federal appropriations not exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues in any fiscal year.

1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
2 state of Michigan, That the congress of the United States is
3 petitioned to adopt an amendment to the constitution of the
4 United States, for submission to the states for ratification,
5 requiring, in the absence of a national emergency, that the total
6 of all federal appropriations made by the congress for any fiscal
7 year not exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues for
8 that fiscal year.

1 Resolved further, That certified copies of this joint
2 resolution be transmitted by the secretary of state to the
3 president of the United States Senate, to the speaker of the
4 United States House of Representatives, and to each member of
5 this state's delegation to the congress and that printed copies
6 be sent to each house of each state legislature in the United
7 States.
