

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION I

February 14, 1995, Introduced by Senators CARL, GOUGEON, ROGERS, STILLE, STEIL and NORTH and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 46 of article IV, to provide for a death penalty for capital murder.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to provide for a death penalty for capital murder, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

- 1 ARTICLE IV
- 2 Sec. 46. No A law shall MAY be enacted providing for
- 3 the penalty of death UPON A CONVICTION FOR CAPITAL MURDER AS
- 4 DEFINED BY LAW.
- 5 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
- 6 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
- 7 in the manner provided by law.
