

RE-DIRECT CONVENTION DOLLARS TO TRANSPORTATION FUND

House Bills 4763 and 4764 Sponsor: Rep. Alvin Kukuk Committee: Appropriations

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 4763 AND 4764 AS INTRODUCED 5-8-97

The bills would direct collections from taxes on spirits (liquor) imposed under the Tourism and Convention Facility Promotion Tax Act to the Michigan Transportation Fund instead of the Convention Facility Development Fund. That act levies two specific taxes of four percent each on the retail sale price of spirits. House Bill 4763 would amend the Tourism and Convention Facility Promotion Tax Act (436.145) and House Bill 4764 would amend the State Convention Facility Development Act (207.626 et al.).
