A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5263 AS INTRODUCED 10-9-97

The bill would amend the Whistleblowers' Protection Act to protect an employee from being fired, threatened, or otherwise discriminated against by his or her employer if the employee publicly discussed issues related to the employer that affected public safety, health, or welfare.
