A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5563 AS INTRODUCED 2-10-98

House Bill 5563 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to change the definition of "historic vehicle." Under the bill, an historic vehicle is defined as a vehicle that is over 25 years old, and that is not used for general transportation, but instead is used solely for participation in club activities, exhibitions, parades, and the like. Under the current law, the definition of an historic vehicle includes these terms, and also specifies that the vehicle "is owned solely as a collector's item."
