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Senate Bill 1082 (as reported without amendment) Sponsor: Senator Mat J. Dunaskiss Committee: Finance

<u>CONTENT</u>

The bill would amend the Income Tax Act to provide that the income tax rate would be 4.0% in 2003.

The bill is tie-barred to Senate Bills 1079, 1080, 1081, and 1083; these bills, with Senate Bill 1082, propose to reduce the State income tax from the current rate of 4.4% to 3.9% over a five-year period ending in 2004. After 2004 the rate would remain 3.9%.
